PROPOSALS TO HOST ALTERNATIVE 3RD PARTY PRE-PAID ELECTRICITY VENDING SITES

Proposals to host pre-paid electricity vending operations in Sibongile, Sithembile and Glencoe are invited from owners and tenants of suitable sites.

Proposals must indicate the following:-

- (i) the hours the site will be available for vending
- (ii) any security arrangements that exist
- (iii) their financial ability to purchase electricity upfront
- (iv) suitability of staff to operate a computer, card swiper and handle cash
- (v) willingness to process the free monthly 50kwh prepaid electricity voucher to those on Council's indigent list at no cost

It should be noted that pre-paid electricity will have to be sold at the same price as that as determined by Council's tariff of charges, however a commission of 3.5% on total sales will be paid to the successful vendors at the end of each month.

In terms of Section 38 of Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, bids from bidders who are in arrears with rates and service charges will not be considered.

Applications indicating the relevant details of the responsible person should be deposited in sealed envelopes marked "Proposals to host alternative 3rd party pre-paid electricity vending sites" in Council's tender box on the ground floor, Civic Centre, 64 Victoria Street, Dundee by no later than 12h00, 22 September 2010.
